- Play an active role in gathering and presenting ideas or suggestions for online publication improvement
- Consistently monitor the blog to ensure all content is representative of the Scholars' programs
- Meet required deadlines
- Lead each semester's meeting
- Lead weekly senior leadership meetings with the Scholars' Programs Coordinator
